In this special report, the International Wine Review focuses the spotlight on the magnificent wines of Montefalco, located in Italy's Umbria region, and profiles the small group of talented winemakers who are crafting wines from the indigenous Sagrantino grape. With just 660 hectares of vines, Sagrantino is one of Italy's least cultivated grape varieties. It was in danger of disappearing altogether until pioneering producers resuscitated it and showed the world what impressive wines it could make. Sagrantino di Montefalco was granted DOCG status in 1992. At the end of this report, we provide reviews and ratings of many of the top wines of Montefalco available in the US market.

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
